

BYLAWS OF THE BOARD

COMMUNITY MEMBER COMMITTEE PARTICIPATION

INTRODUCTION

The Board of Education seeks to include broader engagement by allowing participation of community members on designated Board of Education committees. Participation on committees by members of the community is intended to provide the board the benefit of additional expertise while providing additional community input.

COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP

Appointment:

Appointment of a community member to a committee is by the Chair of the Board of Education and approved by a majority vote of the Board of Education. The appointee serves at the discretion of the Board Chair and may be removed from appointment by the Board Chair at any time.

Roles and Responsibilities:

The committee appointees will conduct themselves in the same manner as all Board of Education members and are subject to all provisions of Board Policy regarding conduct. Appointees must avail themselves of the next available Board of Education member orientation program after appointment.

While appointees may fully participate in all committee meetings and discussions, they shall not be eligible to vote.

Participating Committees:

Appointees may be appointed to such committees as determined appropriate by the Board of Education on an annual basis.

Committee Constitution:

The Chair of the Board of Education will appoint no more than two community members to designated committees. The Chair, at his/her discretion, may appoint additional participants to Special/Advisory Committees based on identified needs of the committee.

It is anticipated that there will be one appointee per member community, however, the Chair may elect to only appoint such volunteers as the Chair deems appropriate.
