

BYLAWS OF THE BOARD

Quorum

A majority of the members of the Board of Education shall constitute a quorum (six members). The affirmative vote of a majority of those members present at any meeting having a quorum shall be considered sufficient for action except for actions required otherwise by law or these policies.

The only business that can be transacted in the absence of a quorum is to take measures to obtain a quorum, to fix the time to adjourn, or to take a recess.
