Student Activity Accounts

A student activity account may be established for each individual class at Coginchaug Regional High School for the purpose of receiving funds and paying for class obligations. The senior class may not incur new obligations after graduation. Once the graduating class obligations are paid, the outstanding balance must be permanently transferred to an account established for the purpose of providing financial support to Regional School District 13 students in grades K-12 on an individual basis.

The support can include, but is not limited to, class trips (excluding those out of the country), activity fees (except parking), the lunch program, and yearbook and graduation costs. It will be the responsibility of the building administrator to present the request to the Superintendent of Schools, who will be the sole decision maker.
