



Student-Parent Agreement 2011-2012

To make the children's experience a success, we are requiring that parents who are registering their children for the production sign the following agreement. It will assist everyone in remembering and understanding the commitment involved in participating in the Aristocats theatre production.

1. An adult from each family will volunteer for at least two of the five performances, OR for one performance and the cast party. Parents who are Committee Chairs will not be required to work any of the shows or the cast party. Rhonda will assign volunteer shifts well in advance. Please be sure to mark your calendars to keep the show and cast party dates open.
2. Cast members are expected to be at all of their scheduled rehearsals. Upon a cast member's 3rd missed rehearsal, his/her part will be reassigned to another student, and the cast member will be assigned to a chorus.
3. Cast members are expected to attend their rehearsals in their entirety. Leaving early and arriving late will count as an absence.
4. Students performing in the Memorial and Strong School plays will be excused from rehearsal(s) the week leading up to their respective performances. Students competing in OM competition will be excused from rehearsal(s) the week leading up to their competition.
5. Cast members are expected to be *Off Book* by the date Heather assigns. When a student is *Off Book*, it means that he/she has memorized his/her part without line-prompting. Any cast member who is unable to perform his/her assigned part by the *Off Book* date will have his/her part reassigned to someone else, and the cast member will be assigned to a chorus.
6. During the last two weeks of May, rehearsal attendance for cast members is mandatory for performance participation.
