

Lyman Band Notes

To Parents of Band Students,

This is just a note to let you know that 4th grade band is going to be starting next Monday, October 24, at 2:15. We originally planned to start on Monday, October 31, but that is the time of the Halloween parade. **All Monday instrument lessons will still take place on October 31 and we will continue with band class the following week on November 7.**

If your child has a lesson on Tuesday, this will be a new routine: bring instrument and book on Monday **and** Tuesday. What I usually recommend is to have your child set up instrument and lesson book ready to go the night before and placed by whatever door you leave your home. If your child forgets his/her instrument I request that he/she find me at school before 9:00 A. M. (when I start teaching). We do have a limited number of loaners that I can issue to students who forget their instrument, or for students whose instrument is being repaired. If you're renting an instrument, you have the right to ask for a loaner from the rental store while your child's instrument is being repaired.

I look forward to starting band class with all the fourth grade instrumentalists next Monday. Just so that you know, I am still looking for band volunteers for the Monday band class. There is only one of me and I will have over fifty students in band, so we do need a few parents to help out. The time you would need to volunteer is from 2:00 to 3:00 P.M. So far I have one parent signed up, but she may only be able to help out once in a while.
