Dear Parents,

HALLOWEEN IS COMING! With it comes our annual school-wide parade, assembly and classroom parties. The afternoon's events will begin at approximately 2:00 p.m. on **Monday, October 31st** with a **HALLOWEEN PARADE**.

Children will put on their costumes after lunch around 1:45 p.m. Please keep in mind several important considerations regarding costumes:

- The costume should be one that your child can put on in the classroom.
- It should be brought to school in a labeled bag. At the end of the day, the costume may be worn home on the bus if it doesn't present a potential safety problem.
- Please do not include any accessory that would fall into the category of "weapon," not even a toy weapon!
- Please be sure that your child's costume is appropriately **non**-scary for 5-9 year olds. For example, most of the Scream costumes are inappropriately scary for this age group and therefore should not come to school.
- Masks are discouraged if they limit the child's vision.

Parents are welcome to view the parade and to attend the assembly. Classroom parties will end the afternoon's celebration. The JLPA is providing refreshments for these parties. Please do not send in additional goodies unless a teacher or room parent asks you to do so.
