Here are some key points to remember when making deposits at school:

- Only **deposits** are accepted at school. Withdrawals and additional deposits can be made at any Liberty Bank branch.
- All deposits should be in a sealed envelope with the student's name, date, teacher's name, and deposit amount written on it. (Please do not send more than \$20 in cash to school with your child.)
- Whenever possible, checks should be made payable to Liberty Bank, with the account number written in the memo field. If the check is made payable to the

- student, please write "For Deposit Only" and the student's account number on the back of the check.
- Large amounts of coin should be rolled. Coin wrappers can be obtained from your school volunteers or at any Liberty Bank branch.
- Students may bring their deposits to school on your school's assigned banking day.
- A monthly account statement will be mailed to each student's home by Liberty Bank.

Super Saver Reward Program

Each time a student makes a deposit at school, he/she receives 10 Super Saver Points. These points are based on the frequency of deposits that the student makes, not the dollar amount. As the student accumulates Super Saver Points each week, he/she will qualify for different rewards.

The goal of this program is to reinforce the importance of having a savings plan and goal, and to save regularly.

This year we will be offering the following rewards:

- 50 Pts. = Smencil
- 100 Pts. = Flashlight Keychain
- 150 Pts. = String Back Pack
- 200 Pts. = Playing Cards
- 250 Pts. = Flex Calculator
