Learn to Hockey Skate – House League

Learn to Hockey Skate is a beginning, instructional program to teach girls and boys ages 4 and up to hockey skate. It meets for 10 weeks on Sundays from 9:00-9:55a at the outstanding Freeman Athletic Center Hockey Rink at Wesleyan University in Middletown. (some times may vary-see full schedule on our website)

The In House Program is for players ages 5 and up who've mastered the skills in Learn to Hockey Skate and that now want to play in scrimmages. Weekly practices & scrimmages will be held at Wesleyan University on Saturday and Sunday mornings. Players must have complete hockey equipment for this program. The cost of the program includes 1 team jersey. For those interested you may be asked to join your team in playing in a game or in a tournament against other youth hockey clubs. With the experience gained in the In House program a player may want to try out for one of our travel teams.

In House Hockey Winter session - \$300.00 Starts January 7, 2012

Everyone also must register with USA Hockey online at USAHOCKEY.COM prior to completing the Whalers registration; there is no additional charge for players up to age 6.
