### Review of current staffing

It is very difficult to find subs, so the district has created a Virtual Proctor position to be in class while a teacher is teaching from home.

### Review of possible staffing for 2021-2022

Dr. Serino discussed some of the possible changes to staffing that have been impacted by the changes that took place in the 2019-2020 school year. The Director of Curriculum's role has changed significantly in terms of the oversight in district-wide areas. The STEAM Coordinator role has been critical as in bridging

the work between technology and curriculum. This responsibility has been critically important and will be necessary moving into the future.

Based upon student performance additional support positions may be needed to assist students in ELA, math and social emotional areas.
