An instructional model that focuses on the work of the reader. This model balances direct instruction, guided practice and independent practice. Students will have opportunity to self-select books and read a variety of text.

What will my child learn?

- Determine Author's Purpose
- Set reading goals and use checklists
- To read a variety of genres
- To work collaboratively with peers to deepen and extend their thinking
